



Faye Bigger Dodson

February 23, 1936 - August 8, 2015

Ruby Faye Bigger Dodson, 79, of Danville, VA passed away peacefully on Saturday August 8th, 2015 at Danville Regional Medical Center after a decline in health for several months.

Faye was born in Pittsylvania County, VA on February 23, 1936 to the late James Richard Bigger, Jr. and Lottie Moore Bigger. She graduated from Dan River High School in 1954 and worked as an executive secretary for Dibrell Brothers Inc. She was a member of Kentuck Baptist Church where she was an organist for 40 years. Faye had an overwhelming passion and love for music her entire life.

Survivors include a daughter, Amy D. Munson (Christopher) of Los Gatos, CA.; two sons, Stuart N.
