



## Frances Campbell Clark

March 11, 1938 - May 13, 2022

Frances Campbell Clark, 84, of 512 Little Creek Road, Ringgold, Virginia, went home to be with the Lord on Friday, May 13, 2022 at her residence after a decline in her health for several years.
