



## Frances Terrell

October 16, 1918 - April 1, 2011

Mrs. Frances Young Gusler Terrell, 92, of 219 Norwood Drive, died Friday, April 1, 2011, at Danville Regional Medical Center after a decline in health for six months. Mrs. Terrell was born October 16, 1918, in Ferrum, a daughter of the late George Young and the late Minnie Buckner Young.
