



## Frances McGregor Yeatts

November 11, 1933 - September 13, 2022

Frances McGregor Yeatts passed away on September 13, 2022.

Born November 11, 1933, in Pittsylvania County, she was the daughter of Linwood Ford McGregor and Gladys Farmer McGregor.

She grew up in Riceville, VA and was a 1952 graduate of Spring Garden High School.
