Fraser Ward Gore, 83, of Danville, VA, went Home to be with his Lord and Savior on Monday, November 12, 2018, at Moses Cone Hospital, Greensboro, NC, after a decline in health for the past year.

Mr. Gore was born in New Orleans, LA, on February 11, 1935, a son of the late Calvin Ward Gore and the late Julia Gore Hurst. He lived part of his life in Augusta, GA, before moving to Danville in 1967. He worked for Southern Processors, Inc. for twenty-five years. He was a veteran who proudly served his country in the U.S. Navy. He was a faithful member of North Main Baptist Church, where he served as Sunday School Superintendent, Deacon, and visitation team member. In his spare time, he enjoyed making hunting knives, gardening, and playing volleyball.

On July 20, 1956, he married the love of his life, Cecelia Miller Gore, who survives of the residence.
