



Fred Keatts Sr.

October 16, 1931 - March 31, 2025

Fred Keatts, Sr., 93, of Axton, went home to be with his Lord on Monday, March 31, 2025 at his residence.

Born on October 16, 1931 in Axton, he was a son of the late Flournoy Edward "F E" Keatts and Emma May Brumfield Keatts.

Fred will be best remembered as a dairy farmer who owned and operated his own dairy farm. He also worked for Dan River Mills and Tultex. In his retirement he worked for Western Sizzlin', where he made the yeast rolls. Fred was a member of Sugartree Primitive Baptist Church.

On March 17, 1951, he married the love of his life, Mary Lue Gill Keatts, who predeceased him on May 1, 2017.

Fred is survived by his four sons, Fred Keatts, Jr. and his wife, Emma, Mark "Eddie" Keatts and his wife, Shirley, Floyd Keatts, Sr. and his wife, Bonnie, Victor "Jeff" Keatts, and his wife, Vicky; eleven grandchildren; twenty-seven great grandchildren and three great-great grandchildren.

In addition to his parents and wife, Fred was preceded in death by two brothers; six sisters and a grandson, Floyd Ray Keatts, Jr.

The funeral service will be held on Thursday, April 3, 2025 at 2:00 p.m. at Sugartree Primitive Baptist Church with Elder Jamie Hancock and Elder David Bradley officiating. Interment will follow in the Keatts Family Cemetery.
