



Freddie Rudolph Williamson

Freddie Rudolph Williamson, 84 of 3152 Pointer Road, Alton, VA died at his residence on Thursday, September 18, 2014 after being in declining health for the past several months.

Mr. Williamson was born in Rockville, Maryland on July 20, 1930 a son of the late Green Allen Williamson and Lucy Ann Booth Williamson. He had lived all of his life in Halifax, Caswell and Pittsylvania Counties. Mr. Williamson had worked for Chemical Leaman Tank Lines as a driver for a number of years until his retirement. He served with U.S. Marines during the Korean War and he loved to hunt, fish, garden and camping. Mr. Williamson was of the Methodist faith.

In September of 1957 he was married to the late Dorothy McCann Hasty Williamson who died on May 5, 2005.
