Fredrick Thomas "Tommy" Robertson, 28, of Danville, Virginia, passed away on Wednesday, January 15, 2025.

Born on September 14, 1996, Tommy was the son of the late Fredrick "Fred" Morris Robertson and Sharon Whitt Robertson of Danville. He is survived by his sister, Rebecca Robertson of Salisbury, North Carolina; custodial uncle and aunt, Donald and Ginny Robertson of Stoneville, North Carolina; maternal grandmother, Maxine Whitt of Danville; recently connected half-brother, Brent Baker of Ringgold, Georgia; and numerous aunts, uncles, cousins, and other family members.

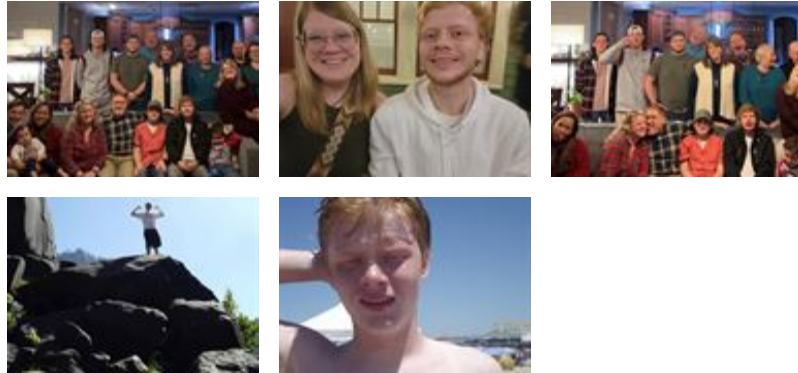

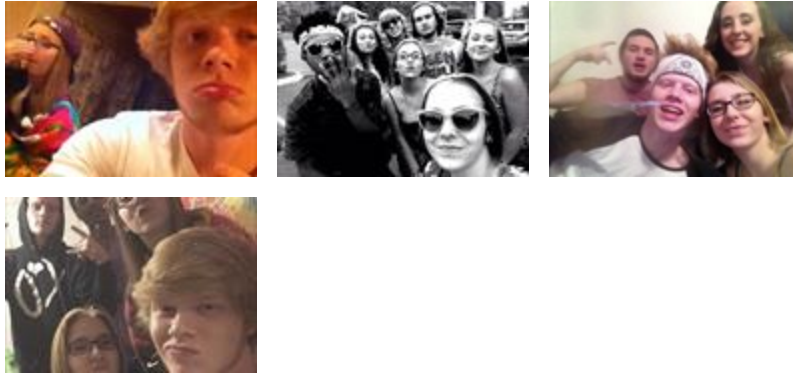

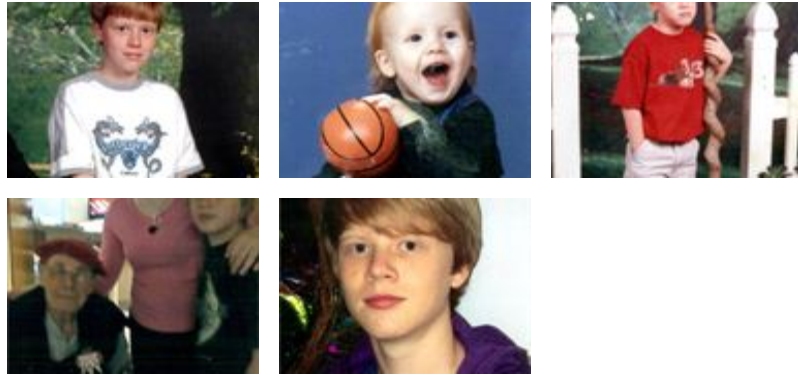
