“ I have always remembered Gail as my champion. I was a new first grader in Fieldale Elementary School and she was in second. While waiting for the bus to pick us up to go home we students would play on the playground. The swings were always occupied by the older children, but one older boy told me he would "count out" another child on the swing so that I could have a turn. (Counting out was the method of turn-taking at the time, that is, if you were older.) So, I got to swing as the older boy pushed me higher and higher, so high that I wasn't able to get out of the swing. As my dress (required then) flew in the air the group of boys around the swing whooped and hollered about my panties, in their full glory. It all sounds cute, but I felt helpless. I was mortified, afraid, and powerless to stop the commotion. Then came Gail, only a year older but totally in control and in command of the situation, demanding that they leave me alone. And they did, stopping the swing and letting me out. She asked if I was okay, comforted me, and stayed with me until the bus arrived. Even now it brings tears to my eyes. How young, how brave, and what a champion she was. That was her character then, and I only imagine it lasted her entire life.
