Gary Wayne Clark, 70, of 3740 Whispering Pines Rd Danville died Sunday, May 19, 2013 at Blue Ridge Village in Martinsville, VA.

Mr. Clark was born on August 11, 1942 in Danville, VA a son of the late Spencer James Clark, Sr. and the late Ora Cook Clark. He spent all of his life in the Danville area where he worked for Goodyear Tire and Rubber Company for twenty seven years until his retirement. Following his retirement he was well known for his ministry, Gary and Friends, performing gospel music for shut-ins, nursing homes, local churches and radio.

He proudly served his country in the US Air Force and the Army National Guard. Mr. Clark was a member of Sandy Shores Baptist Church, serving as choir director and as a deacon.

On June 14, 1969 he married Sylvia Mullins Clark who survives of the residence.

In addition to his wife he is survived by two sons, Carson Wayne Clark and wife Shelby of Sterling, VA and Eric Todd Clark and wife Clover of Cascade, VA; one sister, Ann Kirby of Danville, VA; and three grandchildren, Ashley Clark, Kaden Clark and Spencer Clark.

He was predeceased by two brothers, Spencer J. Clark, Jr. and Lee Clark; and three step brothers, Russell Clark, Daughtrey Clark, and Haywood Clark.

Funeral services will be conducted on Tuesday, May 21, 2013 at 2:00 p.m. from the Wrenn-Yeatts Westover Chapel with the Reverend Billy Scearce officiating. Interment will follow in Danville Memorial Gardens with military

honors by American Legion Post 1097 and the U.S. Army.
