



Gene "Jimmy" T. Morris

Gene (Jimmy) Morris, 90, of Danville, VA passed away peacefully at his home on Monday, May 29, 2023 after several years of declining health.

Born in Ringgold, Virginia on August 24, 1932, he was a son of the late Henry Clay and Billie O. Morris. On July 9, 1955, he married Marjorie S. Morris, who passed away on July 27, 2012.

In his early years, he worked on the family farm and learned the value of hard work. Later, he worked at Morris Cleaners, Dan River Mills then Daly Enterprises, where he worked as a Project Manager.

Gene was a former member of Glenwood Baptist Church and is a current member of Ringgold Baptist Church where he attended until his health declined. He served as a Deacon at both churches.

Gene served in the U.S. Army during the Korean War, however he never left the states.

Gene is survived by his brother, Ray O. Morris, and his wife, Debbie; a great-nephew, James Clay Morris; devoted friend, Robin Setliff and a number of cousins and neighbors.

In addition to his parents and wife, he was preceded in death by a niece, Tina Morris Angel.
