George Emerson Childress, 86, formerly of Meadowbrook Drive, Danville, VA died in Roman Eagle Memorial home on Tuesday, June 05, 2012 after being in declining health for the past two years. Mr. Childress was born in Pittsylvania County on June 29, 1925 a son of the late William Witcher Childress and Madie Ellen Mitchell Childress. He had lived most of his life in Pittsylvania County and Danville where he had retired from the Goodyear Tire & Rubber Company after several years of service.
