



## George Morris

June 25, 1922 - September 10, 2009

George Dallas Morris, Jr., age 87, formerly of 1222 Richmond Blvd., died Thursday afternoon in Roman Eagle Memorial Home where he had been a patient for the past four months. He had been a resident at the Stratford House for two years prior. He had been in declining health for four years. Mr. Morris was born on June 25, 1922 in Danville, a son of the late George Dallas Morris, Sr. and the late Mattie Cloninger Morris. He had lived most of his life in Danville. He was a graduate of the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill with a Business Administration Degree. He served His country honorably as a sergeant in the U.S. Army during World War II, while receiving the Bronze Star. He was the Executive Director of The Danville Redevelopment and Housing Authority until his retirement. He was a member of Poquoson Tribe #124, Improved Order of Redmen and a member of the Morotock Masonic Lodge #210. He attended the Christ Episcopal Church. Mr. Morris is survived by his wife, Geraldine Marshall Morris of Roman Eagle Memorial Home, Danville, two sons, Dr. George Dallas Morris, III and wife, Glenda Morris of Danville, John & David Morris and wife, Jean Morris of Durham, N.C., one brother, Mack Morris of Richmond, Va., one brother-in-law, M.M. Marshall and wife, Rev. Betty D. Marshall of Chatham, Va.
