George Myron Rhamy, 77, of Danville, VA, died on Thursday, March 11, 2021, at Duke University Hospital after a brief decline in health.

Mr. Rhamy was born on September 9, 1943, in Bridgeport, Connecticut to the late Myron Cecil Rhamy and Grace Ida Gilman Rhamy. He resided in Danville since 2007 where he volunteered as a truck driver for God's Pit Crew. He was a member of Trinity United Methodist Church. He will be remembered as a loving husband, a devoted father and grandfather and a man who's generosity knew no bounds. He will truly be missed.

He was married to Elizabeth Rogers, of Tampa Florida, on Valentine's Day 1963.
