George Layman Scott, 89, of 154 Nelson Avenue, died Thursday, April 8, 2010 at Roanoke Memorial Hospital after a decline in his health for the past two years. Mr. Scott was born in Patrick County, VA on May 25, 1920, a son of the late Nora Jane Scott. He had moved to Danville in 1942 and had retired in 1985 from Dan River Mills, Inc. where he had worked in No. 3 & 4 Spin, Schoolfield Division. He was a member of Melville Avenue Baptist Church and the Danville Elk's Club. On April 17, 1950 he married Colotta Spencer Scott, who died on February 18, 2000.
