



George "Skippy" Lynch, III

January 25, 1946 - November 10, 2021

George (Skippy) William Lynch, III, 75, of 2220 Ferguson Rd, Ringgold, VA, died on Wednesday, November 10, 2021 at Sovah Health in Martinsville after being in declining health for the past two years.

Skippy was born in Pittsylvania County, VA on January 25, 1946, a son of the late George William Lynch, Jr. and Catherine Barber Lynch. He spent all of his life in the Ringgold area where he worked for Securitas in Dan River Mills as a supervisor until his retirement. He loved to farm and was of the Baptist faith.

Skippy was very patriotic and served his country in the United States Marines from 1964 to 1968 where he fought in Vietnam. He then enlisted in the Reserves from 1968 until 1970.

On June 12, 1970 he married Frances Ann Spence Lynch who survives.

In addition to his wife, Skippy is survived by his son, Scott Kevin Lynch (Karen) of Ringgold, VA; special brother-in-laws, Jack Lee Spence (Nancy) of Ringgold, VA and Larry Anthony Spence (Dacia) of Ringgold, VA; sisters, Ann Dix of Pelham, NC and Brenda McClanahan (Tim) of Danville, VA; brother Bruce Raymond Lynch of Keeling, VA; granddaughters, Jessica Phelps of Brosville, VA, Elizabeth Davies of Chatham, VA and Rebecca Davies of Ringgold, VA; and six great granddaughters.

Funeral services will be conducted on Saturday, November 13, 2021 at 11:00 AM at the Wrenn-Yeatts North Main Chapel with the Reverend Ed Curran officiating. Entombment will follow the service in Danville Memorial Gardens.
