Gladys Tuck Marshall, 96, formally of 212 Farrar Street died Monday, April 10, 2017, at Riverside Health and Rehab.

Mrs. Marshall was born on August 29, 1920, in Gretna, VA, the daughter of the late Otha Herman Tuck and the late Sallie Hines Tuck Plymale. On June 3, 1943, she married John W. Marshall, who predeceased her on September 25, 2007. She retired from Dan River Mills in 1986 after forty years of service. She was a member of Westover Baptist Church and the former Southhall Baptist Church.

Mrs. Marshall is survived by two daughters, Joyce M. Snead (James), of Bassett, VA, and Barbara M.
