July 26, 1936 - October 30, 2010

Glendora Jerusha Gerrald Butts, 74, of 204 Summitt Road went to be with her Lord and Savior on October 30, 2010. She passed away at Roman Eagle Memorial Home where she had been a permanent resident for four months. She had been in declining health for about one year. Mrs. Butts was born in Horry County, S.C. on July 26, 1936. She was the daughter of late Ivey Russell Gerrald and Lutie Williamson Gerrald. She graduated from Floyds High School in Nichols, S.C. and attended Winthrop College in Rockhill, S.C. On December 25, 1959 she married Douglas Malloy Butts Sr. who predeceased her on March 26, 2009. Mrs. Butts was born and raised in S.C. Her first job was as a secretary for Investment Life and Trust Co. in Mullins, S.C. After her marriage she moved to Danville and spent the rest of her life here. While residing in Danville, she worked for James C Greene Insurance Co. for a few years and then later worked as Office Manager for Calvert, Lewis and Smith architects for twenty years. After the business closed, she worked for Crittenden Adjustment Co. as a secretary until her retirement in September 2001. She was a loyal member of Grace Design United Methodist Church where she served as historian, usher and treasurer of UMW for many years. Mrs. Butts was an active member of the Luncheon Pilot Club for twenty seven years having held all offices and positions in the club and the office of President three terms. She represented the club on various international conventions and traveled to Hawaii, Atlanta, GA, Nashville, TN, Boston, MA, New York, NY, San Antonio, TX, Denver, CO, Anaheim, CA, Cincinnati, OH,

St. Louis, MO, Phoenix, AZ and Reno, NV. Mrs. Butts was a lifetime friend to many and showed her love and kindness to all she met. She exhibited courage, strength and a positive attitude as she fought her battle with cancer. Mrs. Butts is survived by a daughter, Pamela Butts Vaughan and husband J. Kenneth Vaughan of Axton and a son, Douglas Malloy Butts Jr. and wife Lisa Allen Butts of Danville; Three grandchildren, Tabitha Vaughan, Kayla Vaughan, and Emily Butts.
