Gloria Saunders Oliver, 73, of 1062 Halifax Road, Danville, VA, died Sunday, August 10, 2014 at her residence after a decline in her health for the last six years.

Born in Washington, DC, on December 21, 1940, she was a daughter of the late Howard James Saunders and Louisa Morris Saunders Trent.
