Rev. Gregory Stephen Nunley, 44, of 118 Thrush Street, Danville, VA went home to be with his Lord on Tuesday, March 7, 2017 at his residence after a courageous battle with cancer.

Greg was born on July 20, 1972 in Ashland, KY, son of the late John Wesley Nunley, Jr. and Linda Darlene Loar Kelly Nunley, who survives of Ashland, KY. He graduated from Lexington Theological Seminary, was a Disciples of Christ Ordained Minister, and was a supply pastor for Williamson Memorial Presbyterian Church. Greg was a loyal husband and father, who will be greatly missed by his family and friends.

On February 27, 1998, he married Stacy Rene Davis Nunley who survives of the residence.

In addition to his wife, his loving children, Kathryn, Abbey, Belle, Nate, Alaina, Jordan, and Maia; a sister, Cheryl; a brother, David; sister-in-law, Michelle Wilkerson Nance; and a nephew, Roland Nance, survive him.
