



## Hallie Bowes Cobb

October 3, 1933 - May 29, 2021

Hallie Sue Bowes Cobb, 87, of 499 Mise Rd., Yanceyville, NC, went Home to be with the Lord on Saturday, May 29, 2021, at her residence, after a decline in health for the past two years.

Mrs. Cobb was born on October 3, 1933, in Caswell County, NC, a daughter of the late John Willie Bowes and the late Essie Murray Bowes. Since 1980, she had lived in Greensboro, NC, where she worked as an office manager for Cobb Chiropractic until her retirement. In 2018 she moved back to Yanceyville. She was a graduate of Bartlett Yancey High School where she was President of the first Beta Club. She was a lifelong member of Beulah Baptist Church where she was Pianist for 50 years.

She was married to John Lewis Cobb, who predeceased her on February 19, 2011.

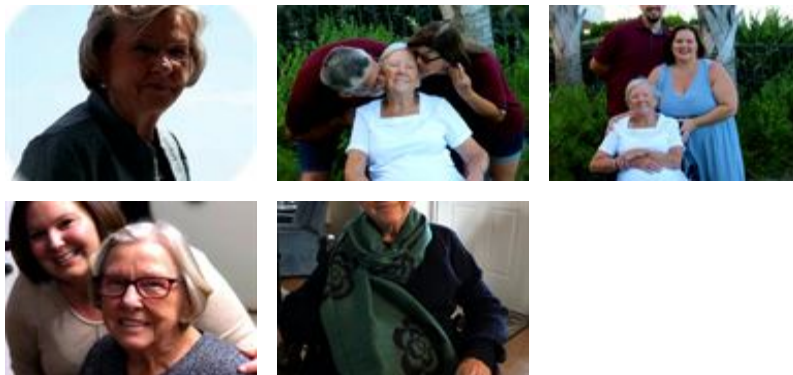
