March 31, 1930 - April 26, 2012

William Harold Cundiff, 82, of 461 Samuel Road, Danville, VA, died Thursday, April 26, 2012 at Danville Regional Medical Center after a decline in his health for the past two months.

Born March 31, 1930 in Pittsylvania County, VA, he was the son of the late William Grady Cundiff and Ruth Gray Linthicum Cundiff.

He lived in the Climax community prior to moving to Danville, VA, and retired from Danville Community College (1964-1992) as an Associate Professor of Electronics.

He was a veteran, serving in the U.S. Army (1953-1955) during the Korean War in Verdun, France as a radio communications operator.

On November 25, 1955 he married Alice Poole Cundiff, who survives.

He was a member of Hollywood Baptist Church and attended Mt. Hermon Baptist Church. He enjoyed photography, flying, and genealogy. He was a member of the American Legion Post 325, the Danville Pilots Club and the DCC Photography Club.

In addition to his wife, of the residence, he is survived by four daughters,

Deborah C. O'Brien, and husband Jamie, of Raleigh, NC, Carol Cundiff, of Cary, NC, Pam C. Motley, and husband Mike, of S. Boston, VA, and Beverly K. Cundiff, of Danville, VA.

Mr. Cundiff was predeceased by a brother, J.P. Cundiff and two sisters, Rachel Amos and Jean Hiler.

Funeral services will be held Sunday, April 29, 2012 at 3:00 p.m. from the Wrenn-Yeatts, North Main Chapel with the Reverend Curtis English and the Reverend Bill Soyars officiating. Interment will follow in Danville Memorial Gardens with military honors by the Army National Guard.
