Harold Eugene Park, 87, of 352 Cumberland Drive, Danville, VA, died Saturday, June 25, 2016 at his residence after a decline in his health since November of 2015.

Mr. Park was born in Fort Wayne, Indiana on December 17, 1928, a son of the late Raymond Eugene Park and Flossie Park Stevens. He lived most of his life in Richmond, VA, before moving to Danville in 2008. He enjoyed woodwork, growing flowers and was an avid gardener. He was of the Baptist faith.

Mr. Park retired after 40 years from Westvaco where he worked as a machine operator.

In February of 1955, he married Margaret Louise Hawkins Park, who died in 2002.
