April 16, 1924 - March 17, 2012

Harry Calvin Scarce, 87, of 2217 Whitmell School Rd, Dry Fork, VA died Saturday March 17, 2012 at his residence after a decline in health for past several months.

Born in the Whitmell Community of Pittsylvania County, on April 16, 1924 he was the son of the late Wade Hampton Scarce, Sr. and Annie Riddle Scarce.

Mr. Scarce retired as a Superintendent of the City of Danville Water, Gas and Electrical Department after 35 years of service. He was an active member of Whitmell Christian Church as long as his health permitted. He served in the U.S. Army during WWII and the Korean Conflict. He was a member of the American Legion Post # 325.

On November 1, 1948 he married Mamie Haskins Scarce who died on May 10, 2007.

He was the last survivor of his generation.

Survivors include two sons, Harry Stephen Scarce and Bobby Wayne Scarce, both of Dry Fork; three grandchildren, Chris Scarce (Jill), Matthew Scarce, and Timothy Scarce; three great-grandchildren, Tyler, Holly, and Maggie Scarce.

In addition to his wife he was predeceased by a son, Donald Calvin Scarce, four sisters, Launa McBride, Geneva ? Jackie? Brown, Rebra H. Goad, and Erna Adkins; two brothers, Hampton Scarce and James Scarce.

Graveside services will be held on Tuesday, March 20, 2012 at 11:00 AM at Highland Burial Park conducted by Minister Tim Oakes. The family will receive friends on Monday from 7:00-8:30 PM at the Wrenn-Yeatts Westover Chapel and at the residence at other times.
