Harvey Brincefield, Jr., 86, of 249 Wyndover Drive died Tuesday, November 03, 2015 at Danville Regional Medical Center after a decline in health for the past year.

Mr. Brincefield was born in Pittsylvania County on May 26, 1929, the son of the late Harvey Brincefield, Sr., and Eloise Lumpkin Brincefield.
