



## Harvey Jackson Turner

September 14, 1924 - July 9, 2013

Harvey Jackson Turner, 88, died on Tuesday, July 9, 2013 at Danville Regional Medical Center after being in declining health for the past two months.

Mr. Turner was born on September 14, 1924 in Ruffin, NC a son of the late Lawson and Georgiana Hardy Turner. He spent most of his life in the Danville area where he worked at Disston as a machine operator until his retirement. He proudly served his country in the US Navy during WWII. He was of the Baptist faith.
