Harvey Wilson Watlington, 93 formerly of Hodges Dairy Road, Yanceyville, NC went to be the Lord on Friday, February 10, 2012 after being in declining for over three years. Mr. Watlington was born in Caswell County on December 6, 1917 a son of the late Otis Ode Watlington and Mattie Elizabeth Page Watlington. He had lived all of his life in Caswell County where he had retired from Tobacco and Truck farming. Mr. Watlington had served as a Caswell County Commissioner for 16 years; he had served as Chairman of the Board of Commissioners from June of 1978 until December of 1979 and as Vice Chairman from December of 1979 to December of 1988. He served on boards and committees of numerous county departments and agencies during his service as a county commissioner along with having served on the Caswell County ABC Board. On December 18, 1948 he was married to the late Annie Dora Carter Watlington. Mr. Watlington is survived by numerous and nephews. He was predeceased by four brothers Julius S. Watlington, Oscar B. Watlington, Sr., Clarence W. Watlington, Bedford J. Watlington, three sisters Hattie E. Watlington, Annie W. McKinney and Margaret W. Brown.
