Edd Hassell Oakley, 89, of 2158 NC Highway 119 North, Leasburg, NC, went home to be with the Lord on Monday, March 24, 2025, at his residence after a three month decline in health.

Hassell was born in Caswell County, NC on July 22, 1935, a son of the late Alonza Oakley and Lucille Rudd Oakley. He had lived all of his life in Caswell County, NC where he worked as a Correctional Officer for the Blanch Department of Corrections. He was known at work as Deacon Oakley and he also was a farmer. Hassell was a member of Beulah Baptist Church where he served as a Deacon, Head Usher and was over the Cemetery.
