June 13, 1919 - December 24, 2017

Hazel Jones Carlton, 98, of Danville, VA, died Sunday, December 24, 2017 at Sovah Health of Danville. Born in Bethel Hill, NC, on June 13, 1919 she was a daughter of the late Edgar Yancey Jones and Mariah Woody Jones.

Hazel lived most of her life in Yanceyville, NC and had been a resident of Danville, VA since 2008. She retired from Western Auto in Yanceyville as co-owner and operator. She was a longtime member of First Baptist Church in Yanceyville, where she served as youth Sunday school teacher and a member of the WMU. She enjoyed fishing, collectables, entertaining, crafts and handmade Christmas ornaments.

Hazel excelled in debating and basketball, going all the way to the N.C. state finals.

Hazel was a wonderful loving wife, mother, and grandmother. Throughout her life, she exhibited strong faith and a joyful thankful spirit. She enriched the lives of so many through her faith in God, her compassion, wisdom, humor and talents.

On February 7, 1943, she married Oscar Daniel Carlton, who died in 1991.

In addition to her husband, she was predeceased by five brothers, Raymond, Ralph, Rupert, Edgar "Dee", and Robert "Bub" Jones; and two sisters,

Marjorie Smithson, and Essie Ruth Umstead.

Survivors include two sons, Danny Carlton (Linda) of Danville, VA, and Rev. Steve Carlton (Suzanne) of Blairs, VA; two grandchildren, Ashley Mills, and Shellie Dotterer; three great grandchildren, Dillon and Evan Mills, and Thomas Pierce; and many nieces and nephews.

Funeral services will be held on Wednesday, December 27, 2017 at 2:00 P.M. at Bethel Hill Baptist Church, 201 Old US Hwy 501, Roxboro, NC, 27574, with Pastor Robert Dunn officiating.
