



## Reverend Henry W. Taylor

January 13, 1920 - January 1, 2015

Reverend Henry W. Taylor, 94, of Danville, VA went home to be with his Heavenly Father on Thursday, January 01, 2015.

Rev. Taylor was born in the Laurel Grove Community of Pittsylvania County on January 13, 1920 to the late David Taylor and Lena Guill Taylor.

Rev. Taylor was the Pastor of St Mark Pentecostal Holiness Church for 52 years, and served in the U.S. Army during WWII. He was also a licensed Pilot.

On July 19, 1941, he married Faye Yeatts Taylor, who survives.

Survivors in addition to his wife include a son, Michael W. Taylor, and wife, Becky, of Ringgold; a son-in-law, Gerald Warren, of Durham, NC; three grandsons, Michael Brandon Taylor, and wife, Heather; Gerry Warren, and wife, Tara; Preston Daniel Taylor, and fiancé, Rayna Somers; five great-grandchildren, Natalie Warren, Ella Warren, Julia Carter, MacKenzie Taylor, and Asher Taylor.

He was predeceased by a daughter, Artie Mae Taylor Warren; two brothers, Bobby and Pete Taylor.

Funeral services will be held on Saturday, January 3, 2015 at 2:00 PM from St

Mark Pentecostal Holiness Church conducted by the Rev. Jerry Foley, the Rev. Roger Collins, and the Rev. Doyle Marley. Interment will follow in Highland Burial Park.
