



## Henry Tuck

November 22, 1918 - March 28, 2010

Henry Howard Tuck, 91, of 141 Kerr Lane, died Sunday, March 28, 2010 at Roman Eagle Memorial Home. He had been in declining health since November of 2009 and a resident of Roman Eagle since February 8, 2010.
