Andrew Herbert Walker, 86, of Danville, VA died Thursday, July 13, 2017 at Roman Eagle Rehabilitation & Health Care Center after a decline in health for the past two years.

Mr. Walker was born in Pittsylvania County, VA on January 11, 1931 a son of the late Joseph Lester Walker and Carrie Payne Walker.

Mr. Walker worked in Home Construction and was of the Baptist faith. He was an avid fisherman and played baseball for 40 years.
