Herman Vann Clark, 94, of 196 Hamlin Avenue died Monday, May 22, 2017 at Riverside Health and Rehabilitation Center. He had been in declining health for 18 months.

Mr. Clark was born December 24, 1922, in Pittsylvania County a son of Eustice Vann Clark and Mattie Hudgins Clark.
