On Monday, November 18, 2024, Hilda Simpson Smith, went home to be with her Lord and Savior Jesus Christ after suffering a massive stroke. Days before her 94th birthday, she heard her Savior say, "Well done, thou good and faithful servant."

Hilda Simpson Smith, 93, of Danville, VA was born in Hurt, VA on November 25, 1930, a daughter of the late Reuben Floyd Simpson and Nannie Short Simpson.
