



## Howard Lee Campbell

Howard Lee Campbell, 77, of 1789 Mount View Road, Danville, VA, died Friday, May 17, 2019 at his residence after a one month decline in his health.

Mr. Campbell was born in Pittsylvania County, VA, on July 1, 1941 a son of the late William Beauford Campbell and Lucy Ingram Campbell.
