



## Howard Edward Gee Sr.

October 20, 1924 - June 14, 2017

Howard Edward Gee, Sr., 92, of 1925 Ringgold Rd. Lot 21, Ringgold, VA, died on Wednesday, June 14, 2017, at Danville Regional Medical Center after being in declining health for the past few months.

Mr. Gee was born in Milton, NC, on October 20, 1924, a son of the late Lewis Oliver Gee and the late Ada Grant Gee. He lived his entire life in the Ringgold Community where he worked for Goodyear Tire & Rubber Company. He was a faithful lifelong member of Ringgold Baptist Church.
