Hugh Irvin Mitchell, Jr., 83, of 280 Parker Road West went home to be with the Lord on Saturday, September 14, 2019 at his residence after a brief decline in health.

Hugh was born in Danville, VA on June 8, 1936 a son of the late Hugh "Major" I. Mitchell. Sr. and Virginia Bethel Staples Mitchell.

Hugh served in the US Navy during the Persian Gulf War; he retired from the Navy Reserves. He worked for Dan River Inc. where he was a mechanic. He was a faithful member of Holland Road Baptist Church where he sung in the choir and was an usher. He was a member of American Legion Dan River Post # 1097.

On November 25, 1971, he married Faye Mills Mitchell, who survives of the residence.

Survivors also include his daughter, Teresa Horne Cannon, a brother, Roger Lee Mitchell, and wife, Jane; two grandsons, Chad Horne, and wife, Melissa, Tyler Scott Cannon; two great-grandchildren, Braylen and Aubrey Horne; and a number of nieces and nephews.
