Mr. Lunsford was born on September 7, 1929 a son of the late Hunter Lee Lunsford, Sr. and the late Ruth Willis Lunsford. Mr. Lunsford was born and raised in Yanceyville, North Carolina and spent most of his life in the Danville area where he worked for Sears & Roebuck for 22 years prior to working as an agent for Life of Virginia until his retirement in 1995.
