Ida Irene Harris Carter, 88, of 182 Powell Avenue, Danville, VA, died Monday, November 9, 2015 at Roman Eagle Memorial Home after a decline in her health since 2000.

Born in Bartley, Nebraska on September 3, 1927 she was the daughter of the late Paul William Harris and Lorene Smith Harris. She moved to Danville, VA in 1948. She worked for A & P Supermarket and retired from Old Dutch Supermarket where she worked as a cashier for many years. She was a charter member of United Baptist Church, formerly Keen Street Baptist Church where she served as a Sunday School Teacher for sixty years. She was Woman of the Year twice. She will be loved and missed by all.

Ida Irene was married to the late Robert Edward Lee Carter, who died on March 24, 1990.

In addition to her husband, she was predeceased by a brother, Grovert Harris.
