



## Jack Andrews

Edwin Jack Andrews, 73 of 401 Kentuck Church Road, Ringgold, VA died at his residence on Saturday, April 27, 2013 after being in declining health for the past several months.

Mr. Andrews was born in Danville, VA on October 14, 1939 a son to the late Edwin R. Andrews and Susie Dunn Andrews. He had lived all of his life in Danville and Pittsylvania County.
