Jack Allan Heater

Jack Allan Heater, 80, of 1357 Westover Dr, died Tuesday, August 9, 2011, at Danville Regional Medical Center after a decline in health for the past five years.

Mr. Heater was born on Lynchburg, VA, on June 4, 1931, the son of the late Harry G. Heater and Della Hubbard Heater.

He was a letter carrier for the U.S. Postal Service, and a very active member of Woodlawn Baptist Church. He served his country in the U.S. Air Force during the Korean War.

On March 21, 1959, he married Margaret Sorgee Heater, who survives.

Other survivors include a son, Jay Heater, of St. Augustine, FL; two daughters, Jayne Oravec, of Danville, and Joan Covington, of Clarksville; a sister Shirley Chandler, of Danville; and a brother Charles Heater, of Urbunna, VA, six grandchildren.

In addition to his parents he was predeceased by a brother, Benny Heater.

Graveside services will be held at Danville Memorial Gardens on Thursday, August 11, 2011 at 11:00 A.M. conducted by the Rev. Curtis Faison. The family will receive friends on Wednesday evening from 7-8:30 P.M. at the Wrenn-Yeatts Westover Chapel, and at other times at the residence.
