Reverend James Haywood Albert, 80, of 210 Walters Mill Road, Providence, NC went home to be with Lord on Monday, February 21, 2022 in Moses Cone Hospital after a short decline in health.

James was born in Orange County, NC on June 21, 1941 a son of the late Edgar O'Kelly Albert and Bessie Crabtree Albert. He had lived all of his life in Person & Caswell County. James was the founder and organizer of Community Baptist Church in Danville where pastored for 40 years prior to his retirement. After his retirement James continued to preach once a month at Holiday Village and for other churches in the area.

On November 23, 1960 James married the late Christine H. Albert who went home to be with the Lord in July of 2013. On December 31, 2014 James remarried Verna C. Albert who survives of the residence.
