



## James Coleman

July 28, 1919 - July 4, 2010

James William "Billy" Coleman, 90, of 5001 Franklin Turnpike, Danville, VA died Sunday, July 4, 2010 at his residence after a decline in his health for the past four years. Mr. Coleman was born July 28, 1919 in Pittsylvania County, VA, a son of the late Ballard Comer Coleman and Rosa Robertson Coleman. He had lived his life in Danville and in Pittsylvania County and had retired, after 25 years, from Auto Specialty Company where he had worked as owner and operator.
