James Carter Coleman, Jr., 69, of 1676 Dodson Road, Blairs, VA passed away on Sunday, October 22, 2023 at Sovah Health after being in declining health for the last three months.

Mr. Coleman was born in Williamston, NC on December 11, 1953 a son of the late James Carter Coleman, Sr. and Delores Parsons Coleman.
