James Edward Doss, 86, of 425 Woodlawn Drive, Danville, VA, died Saturday, April 9, 2011 at his residence. He had been in declining health for the past five years.

Born November 16, 1924 in Pittsylvania County, VA, he was a son of the late Nollie Witt Doss and Edith Holley Doss. He had attended the Burlington Public Schools and had lived most of his life in Danville, VA. He retired from Suburban Propane Company and he was of the primitive baptist faith. He enjoyed fishing on the coast and he was an avid race fan.
