



Jimmy Lawrence Hollie

June 14, 1960 - February 16, 2025

James Lawrence (Jimmy) Hollie, 64, of 555 Countryside Drive, Ringgold died Sunday, February 16, 2025. He had a recent decline in health.

Jimmy was born June 14, 1960, a son of James Edward Hollie and Marie Barker Hollie and had spent his life in the Ringgold community. He retired after 35 years with O-I (Brockway) Glass Manufacturing. After retiring, Jimmy was able to achieve a lifelong dream of starting a cattle farm and the “James Lee’s Place” farm became a reality. He enjoyed hunting, fishing and farming in his spare time.

Jimmy was a member of the Ringgold Volunteer Fire and Rescue, serving 49 years in various roles, including EMS Captain and most recently served as the Secretary of the Board of Directors for the department. He also served on the Pittsylvania County Fire Commission.

Jimmy also was a Life member of the Danville Life Saving Crew and served as an EMT-Cardiac Technician for the crew. He was a member of Ringgold Baptist Church.

On June 23, 1978, he married Brenda Bullock, who survives of the residence.

In addition to his wife, he is survived by two daughters, Kristy Hollie Davis

(Kevin) and Bridgett Hollie Sharpe (Steven), a sister, Sandra Mills (Floyd), three grandchildren, Madison, A.J. and Jacob, a great-grandchild, Eastyn, and numerous nieces and nephews.

Jimmy was preceded in death by his parents, a sister, Vicky Hollie Searce, a son, James Lee Hollie, a nephew, Walter C. Henderson, IV, and a niece, Stephanie Neal.

Funeral services will be conducted at 2:00 PM on Friday, February 21, 2025 at Ringgold Baptist Church by the Reverend Duane Caldwell. Interment will follow at Highland Burial Park. The family will receive friends for one hour prior to the service, and at other times they will be at the residence.

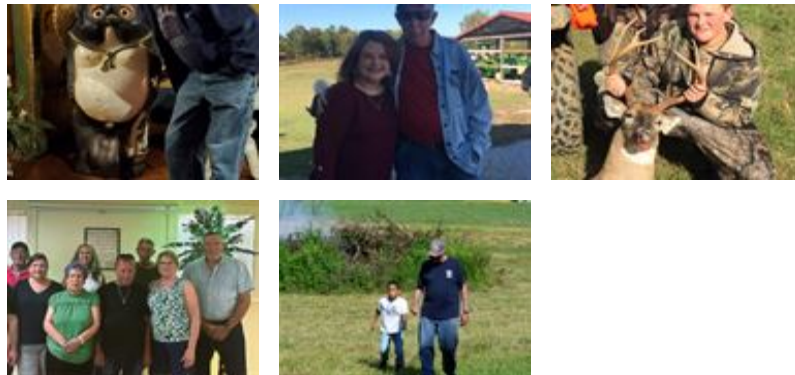
