



## James Hughes

January 27, 1933 - April 18, 2012

Mr. James Earl Hughes, age 79 of 300 Parkland Drive, passed away early Wednesday morning after a decline in health for the past year.

Mr. Hughes was born on January 27, 1933 in Halifax County, VA, a son of the late Earl Winston Hughes and the late Annie Richie Hughes. Mr. Hughes was employed by Dan River Inc. as a Supply Clerk until his retirement. He served in the U.S. Army.
