



## James "Jim" Kendrick

October 14, 1942 - April 27, 2013

Mr. James "Jim" Kendrick, age 70 of 5996 Kentuck Road, Ringgold, died at Danville Regional Medical Center, Saturday, April 27, 2013 after a decline in health for the past two years.

Mr. Kendrick was born on October 14, 1942 in Pittsylvania County, a son of the late Eugene Kendrick and the late Gladys Pack Kendrick. He had lived most of his life in the Danville area where he was employed by Disston, Inc. in the Saw Department until his retirement due to his health. He was of the Baptist faith.
