August 5, 1919 - January 3, 2011

James Allen McAllister, 91, of 4110 Westover Drive, Danville, VA, died Monday, January 3, 2011 at Abington Place.

Born August 5, 1919 in Danville, VA, he was a son of the late Reverend William Allen McAllister and Madge Eggleston McAllister. He had lived his life in Danville, VA, and had graduated from Schoolfield High School and had completed undergraduate courses at UVA Extension and Averett College in Danville. He worked for Haynesworth Office Supply Company from 1945 until 1959, Link-Watson Corporation as credit manager from 1959 until 1965, and Haynesworth/Office Plus, from 1965 until his retirement as a sales representative.

Mr. McAllister was a member of Saint John's United Methodist Church and a member of the Dan River Sertoma Club and the Danville Exchange Club. He was active with the Boy Scouts of America and the Little Theater of Danville. He loved photography and writing poetry.
