Janet Carolyn Reynolds Pruitt, 64, of 122 Hayes Court, Danville, VA, went to be with her Lord on Saturday, June 21, 2012 at her residence after being in declining health for the past seven months. Mrs. Pruitt was born in Danville, VA, on August 2, 1947 a daughter of the late Rev. H. T. Reynolds and the late Gracie Jefferson Reynolds. Living her entire life in Danville, she was the pastor of the Full Gospel Revival Chapel and president of the H. T. Reynolds Evangelistic Association, where she had worked since 1974. Continuing the work of her father, she proclaimed the gospel through books, magazines, and radio broadcasts. She expressed her deep-felt faith in Jesus Christ through her personal witness and humble service to God and others. However, more than anything, she truly embodied the fruit of the Spirit spoken of in Galatians 5:22-23. She was a graduate of Tunstall High School and married James Fisher Pruitt on April 2nd, 1966. In addition to him, she is survived by two sons, Brian David Pruitt and Timothy Allan Pruitt, and by her sister Joan Marie Reynolds. She is predeceased by her brother David Lee Reynolds. A service in celebration of her life and ministry will be held at 4 p.m. on Sunday June 24th at Wrenn-Yeatts Westover Chapel, with her cousin, the Rev. Michael E. Hearp officiating. Interment will follow in the Swansonville Pentecostal Holiness Church Cemetery. The family will be receiving friends all day Saturday at the residence, 122 Hayes Court, Danville, VA 24541.
